... that the Port of Philadelphia benefits from Australian trade? The Port of Philadelphia is the principal discharge port in the U.S. for Australia and New Zealand's refrigerated cargo. In 2009, 56 percent of Australia's meat exports to the U.S.A. were 'off loaded' in Philadelphia. **Philadelphia** is the also the No. 1 discharge port in the U.S. for Australian dairy products, canned fruit, and **is a major destination for Australian wine.** Additionally, Philadelphia is an important export port for paper, machinery and food products shipped to Australia.

The Australian Wine Industry is the fourth largest exporter of wine around the world, shipping 760 million litres of wine a year. Australia's wine regions are mainly in the southern, cooler parts of the country, with vineyards located in South Australia, New South Wales, Victoria, and Western Australia. The major varieties of wine are predominantly Shiraz, Cabernet Sauvignon, Chardonnay, Merlot, Semillon, Pinot Noir, Riesling, and Sauvignon Blanc. The wine industry is a significant contributor to the Australian economy through production, employment, export and tourism.
